## Congress Started – 19.00 hours

# 6. Women's Report by Denise Offermann

All women agreed that all facilities and equipment were in place and in great condition. Also the training place nearby was very welcomed. There was some very good lifting observed from the women. The number of entries increase yearly so does the quality of lifting. Women's qualifying standards need to be updated. Some interesting new records have been broken.

## 7. European Masters Hall of Fame

Claire Cameron (GBR) and Caroline Charles (GBR) both initiated into the European Masters Hall of Fame at the 2015 European Masters, Bangor University.

### 8. 2016 Bids:

Azerbaijan Masters chairman Natig Aghayev informed everybody that he wants to organize another European Masters WL Championship again Nakchivan, where the 2014 World Masters Cup was held with success. Mr. Aghayev emphasized that he does not want any share from the entry fees for his organization. He therefore offers his share as part to pay the Visa to enter Azerbaijan. He also informed us that everybody will be able to obtain their visa upon arrival at any airport in Azerbaijan. The European Masters Secretariat will issue the letter of Invitation to those nations who need visa.

BB stated that since no other bid came in Congress is asked to vote for other against Azerbaijan. 14 votes were for and 2 abstain.

# 2016 European Masters WL championships will be held in Nakchivan.

Mr. Aghayev allowed the European Masters Committee to choose the dates.

All national delegates will be informed soon of dates, location of competition hall etc..

Cyprus: D. Offermann at first received an offer from a Russian Crossfit located in Limassol to hold the 2016 or 2017 European Masters Championship. Unfortunately the Crossfit withdrew.

### 2017 EUROPEN MASTERS WL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

BB reminded Europe that the 2017 World Masters Games will take place in Auckland – New Zealandfrom the 21 – 30 April 2017. There will be no European Masters WL Championships at the usual time of the year. Jean – Paul Belmas (FRA) noted that the Club from the Strasbourg area might be interested. He will be hopefully given more specific information later in the year.

BB noted that the European Masters Championships shall be held after summer, around the time where usually the World Masters Championships are held. We hope to get more bids for 2017.
